The running competition will consist of two successive tests. Both events will take place on a loop of **1.8 km** around the site of BRGM.

- The first test will emphasize the participation of various delegations (number of points in proportion to the **number of participants / size of the delegation**)
- The second allow four riders of each delegation (two women plus two men) from each other in a test speed.

Each test will account for 50% of the final standings running.

- Each runner will be identifiable for its participation is effective and should therefore take the tee-shirt of his delegation.
- Any deviation of the route of a rider leads to the elimination of his team.
